- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Government Ayurvedic Mahavidyalaya, Raje Raghuji Nagar, Umrer Road, Sakkardara Chowk, Nagpur-440024, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0171)** inspection was conducted on **15.04.2025 and 16.04.2025 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with intake capacity **100 seats (125 seats including EWS)** in UG (BAMS) course and **60 seats (75 seats including EWS)** in 10 PG course -(i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalaky Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalya Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024, MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report shortcomings/defects were observed and same was communicated to you vide letter of even no. dated 28.05.2025. In response of the same you have submitted the clarification vide letter ref. no. GACN/Est./NCISM/Compliance/Report/7494/2025 dated 31.05.2025 & 21.06.2025.**
- Accordingly, the submitted clarifications and the assessment report was once again carefully examined in terms of concerned Acts & Regulations and provision under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations **thereunder, and after verification observation is as under:-**

- 4) As per the Regulation no. 04 of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024 published on 01st October,2024 there shall be 18 Postgraduate programs in Ayurveda on and from the date of publication of the said Regulations shalakyta Tantra Postgraduate program has been divided into Shalakyta- Netra Roga Chikitsa (Ayurveda Ophthalmology) & Shalakyta- Karna, Naasa and Mukha Raga Chikitsa (Ayurveda Oto-Rhino Laryngology and same was informed to you vide letter **Ref. No.-3/2025/MARB/General Matters dated 05.05.2025**. In response of the same you have sent an email dated **27.06.2025 enclosing the letter vide ref no. PG/516/2025 dated 31.05.2025 in which for 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) of Shalakyta Tantra you have opted for Shalakyta-Netra Roga Chikitsa-03 seats(04 seats including EWS) and for Shalakyta-Karna, Nasa & Mukha Roga Chikitsa-03 Seats** .
- 5) The submission made by the college during clarification and assessment report have been carefully re-examined in terms concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and as per the direction of competent authority the assessment report along with clarification report was once again placed in the **129th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held **on 27.06.2025 and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations in 09 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Rog Nidan – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vii) Shalya Tantra – 06 seats (08 seats including EWS)(viii) Kriya Sharir – 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalakyta Tantra –06 seats(7 seats including EWS)[Opted for Shalakyta Tantra Netra Roga Chikitsa-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) and Shalakyta Tantra Karna, Nasa & Mukha Roga Chikitsa-03 seats] and not fulfilling the criteria for issuance of permission in UG (BAMS) Course and 01 PG Courses in the subject namely (i)Agad Tantra- 06 seats (7 seats including EWS) due to non availability of Professor. However, Board decided to issue yearly permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in the aforementioned PG Courses accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2025-26.**

a) **As per the seat reduction policy 2025-26:-**

For PG Course:-

"In case of non availability of Professor in the Post graduate department or specialty permission shall be granted as per the available teacher student ratio by reducing the intake strength in the concerned department".

As per sub-Regulation 2 of Regulation 19 of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024, The Teacher student ratio shall be subject to availability of student-Postgraduate guide in the ratio of 3:1, for three students for one Professor; in case of Associate Professor 2:1 two students for one Associate Professor; and in case of Assistant Professor the ration is 1:1 one student for one Assistant Professor.

In department of Agad Tantra & Vidhi Vaidyaka - College is having 04 eligible teacher (02 associate professor for UG and PG & 02 assistant professor - 01 for UG and 01 for PG) and there is shortcoming of 01 Professor for UG and 01 professor for PG, however there are 02 associate professor , accordingly as per the available faculty ,college is not fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and **eligible for issuance of permission for only 04 seats (05 including EWS) instead 06 seats (7 seats including EWS).**

For Hospital Staff:-

There is deficiency of 01 Deputy Medical Superintendent., **therefore, in accordance of seat reduction policy 2025-2026, for deficiency of one DMS, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing 01 seat from total intake capacity in UG (BAMS) Course.**

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2025-26 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 and as per the PG Regulation 2024 , college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of yearly permission with 99 seats (124 Seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 Seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course and 58 seats (73 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)] in 10 PG course -(i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir -06 seats (07 seats including EWS)(vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakyia Tantra - 06 seats(7 seats including EWS)[Opted for Shalakyia Tantra Netra Roga Chikitsa-03 seats(04 seats including EWS) and Shalakyia Tantra Karna, Nasa & Mukha Roga Chikitsa-03 seats] (ix) Shalya Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra-04 seats (05 including EWS) [instead 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)]for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

"DECISION"

- 6) Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above Yearly Permission in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and as per the Policy letter dated 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025 is hereby granted to **Government Ayurvedic Mahavidyalaya, Raje Raghuji Nagar, Umrer Road, Sakardara Chowk, Nagpur-440024, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0171) with 99 seats (124 Seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 Seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course and 58 seats (73 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)] in 10 PG course -(i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir -06 seats (07 seats including EWS)(vi) Swasthavritta -06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rog Nidan - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakyia Tantra -06 seats(7 seats including EWS)[Opted for Shalakyia Tantra Netra Roga Chikitsa-03 seats(04 seats including EWS) and Shalakyia Tantra Karna, Nasa & Mukha Roga Chikitsa-03 seats] (ix) Shalya Tantra - 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (x) Agad Tantra-04 seats (05 including EWS) [instead 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)] for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcomings shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-**
- I. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of with 99 seats (124 Seats including EWS) [instead of 100 seats (125 Seats including EWS)] and 15% of Postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of with 58 seats (73 Seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)]** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- 7) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 8) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 9) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 10) **The aforementioned shortcomings as following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024,

- iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- v) The remaining shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 4 , shall be fulfilled.
- 11) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.

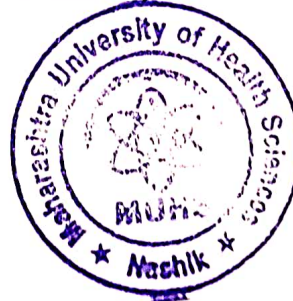
